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We all know that running is good for you, both physically and mentally, and that marathons, fun runs, and everything in between, raise substantial amounts of money for amazing causes worldwide. Brookfield Properties Powai Run (Monsoon Edition) , organized by Rotary Club of Mumbai Lakers is one run that combines all the above elements. It is the flagship fundraiser project for Rotary Club of Mumbai Lakers. It raises awareness, brings people together and inspires thousands across the city of Mumbai to slip into their running shoes, often for the first time, all whilst doing good things for others. This year we had a physical run for 4km -Biggest Run in 2022 in the city of Mumbai!! 10km and 21 km runs were conducted in a Virtual avatar where anyone, anywhere in the world could participate.

The Run has a new theme every year and this year was #BreakThePlasticHabit. The theme is something in which our Title Sponsors, Brookfield Properties, believe very strongly in and have joined hands with RCML in helping Powai break this habit. The team worked on hiring RECIRCLE, an agency that ensured that the event was a ZERO WASTE EVENT and the first of its kind in Powai. It was heartening to see the reports shared by Recircle for our ZERO WASTE RUN.

The Impact: Dry waste- 205 kg; Wet Waste - 65 kg; A Total of 270 Kg of waste was diverted away from festering in the landfills. Dry Waste (Further division): Mixture plastic: 109 Kg; Cardboard: 28 Kg;















PET bottles: 26Kg; Soft Plastic: 5Kg; Paper: 37Kg. This was possible as the entire team responsible for the Powai Run and Carnival showed sensitivity towards the environment & took accountability for the trash generated at the event. Also, the fact that the people of Powai were already Eco-conscious made the task easy for the team to segregate.

The Innovation Run was introduced for the first time at the Powai Run. It was an initiative of RCML, Brookfield Properties and IIT E-cell wherein CXOs from across Mumbai took part in a 4km walk / run along with IIT students. It was a novel way of bringing the leaders of today with the leaders of tomorrow under one roof.

When we raise money for charity, people like to know where the money raised for charity goes, and the real effect and legacy that money has. Powai Run connects people directly to the causes they are fundraising for and helps you see first-hand the impact your involvement has. And then there's that element of challenge, getting people to do something that they previously

thought impossible. When you Run at Powai Run, you can be sure that 100% of the nett funds raised is going for charities supporting causes like Little Heart surgeries, Cancer detection and treatment, girl child education, and various other projects such as making potable water accessible, supporting health and hygiene especially of women and children in rural areas. aivina counselling to oppressed women in the community, conducting medical

camps, planting trees to make the planet greener and many more. All these projects are updated on our social media handles, website and periodically circulated in the community newspaper Planet Powai.

The greatest difference we make is not the fundraising or the work we do for months in preparation of Powai Run. It's the lasting impact it has on the communities. It is the long-term memories you create, especially at the post run Carnival held on the Main Street. People of all ages from 3 to 80 come and participate in this Gala event celebrating with food, Music, dancing, games and general Bonhomie prevails. All these goings-on are part of what makes Powai a great place to live. Besides being fun, RCML's well-managed carnival offers economic and social benefits to new businesses within the community. It instilled a sense of community pride.

There's also the energy and affirmation that comes from it. One lady who

never used to be a runner, but now takes her kids running every weekend and gets her kids involved in charitable giving as a family. She's now, as a mum, influencing her children to think about the world differently, and that's why we do what we do.

The best thing about being involved with Powai Run is the opportunity to help build a community, foster a sense of pride within a community,

BIKE AMBULANCES-RCML Enables Healthcare in Remote Areas

Healthcare in India faces a huge challenge, especially in the rural areas where critical patients find it difficult to reach the hospitals due to the unavailability of ambulances. The hospitals are few and far between, while the topography of the region also presents a huge challenge not only for the distribution of health services but for families to avail of transport services. Donating an ambulance to a struggling healthcare system is a tremendous help. With RCML's support, now modified four-stroke motorcycles, which work as a 'Motor-Bike Ambulance', are proving to be a boon for the people of the region, bridging the last mile to health care. The motorcycle ambulances ferry patients, pregnant women and infants, from remote areas to the nearest primary and Community Health Centers (CHCs) and have emerged as a lifesaver for the people of the region.

These ambulances are fitted with a side-carriage for the comfort of the patient and are equipped with medicines and a functional first-aid kit to meet emergency needs. The ambulances are operated by skilled drivers, adept at providing first-aid. The free service assumes significance for a country like India where the maternal mortality rate (MMR) is 122 per 100,000 live births, many of whom can't get to the hospital in time.

Rotary Club of Mumbai Lakers delivered 2 Bike Ambulances to Palghar on 22nd May, thanks to the support of the residents of Powai. This helped 50,000 people gain access to healthcare — people who previously did not have access to hospitals due to the remoteness of the village — and assisted in saving lives and delivering essential medicines.

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BIKE AMBULANCES-RCML Enables Healthcare in Remote Areas

RCML also supported the delivery of 2 Ambulances worth 1.15 L in total to the Kashmir border area. The ambulances were transported to Kashmir on 23rd June. Kupwara area is a known terrorist-infested area due to its unique topography and dense forests. Many terrorist attacks happen in this area. The army has taken multiple actions to eliminate and stop terrorism and build goodwill. It has started providing medical help to Locals, setting up Army Public Schools for local children and bringing them into the mainstream of the Nation and keeping them away from terrorists. This is working very well and the local population has started backing out forces and the country.

To further strengthen the goodwill, the army has come up with an Immediate Project to provide Locals with MotorCycle ambulances for bringing Villagers and particularly Ladies and children to Army Medical Centres to provide First line Medical Aid and then transfer them to a Proper Hospital in Kupwara or Srinagar. Army CO 56 RR had requested us to immediately provide 02 Motors Cycle Ambulance for helping the Villagers on Borders which is a Big Step towards bringing Villagers closer to the Army and our Nation and keeping them away from any temptation of helping Terrorists. These ambulances were needed as the terrain is not accessible by four-wheelers.

RCML responded immediately by providing 02 Motor Cycle Ambulances to Villagers of Machal Village through Army 56 RR. CO of 56 RR has promised to maintain and operate 02 Motor Cycles Ambulances for Villagers. The support received in the form of ambulances delivered there was hugely appreciated. We did this project in association with the Rotary Club of Bombay Powai. Thank you for partnering in this wonderful cause.

MEDICAL PROJECTS Medical Camp and CPR trainings

Rotary club of Mumbai Lakers Single-mindedly devoted themselves to conducting Medical Camps and CPR training in societies across Hiranandani and in and around Powai. RCML is conducting these camps in association with Dr. L H Hiranandani Hospital. CEO of Dr LH Hiranandani Hospital, Dr. Chatterjee, approached RCML as he wanted everyone in the community to have a Basic CPR training, in the post pandemic world. The CPR training is Coupled with a Medical camp again conducted by the Doctors of Hiranandani Hospital.

At the camps conducted in the various housing societies building staff, maids, drivers as well as the residents in large number are examined for BP, Bone density, HGL sugar and free doctor consultation is provided. CPR trainings are conducted by Dr Samrat, who heads the Emergency of Dr LH Hiranandani Hospital and Mr Kazi helps with hands on training of CPR for the resident. Special Thanks to Mr. Deepak of Hiranandani hospital, who has been coordinating these camps and has been instrumental for the success of this initiative of RCML. Efforts of President Nimish Agarwal, along with Lakers Shaili Shah and Chetna Lall have taken this campaign to the levels of success it has reached today, with more and more societies coming forward and approaching the team for conducting this camp in their buildings.

The average number of beneficiaries in each medical camps was 100.










BLOOD DONATION




RCML organised a blood donation camp on 24th April at Dr LH Hiranandani Hospital. We collected 70 units of blood.












HEARING AID DONATION

SUPPORT FOR THALASSEMIA KIDS

RCML supported 20 Thalassemia Kids' Transfusion through Think Foundation. The cost of the project is 2.4 Lakh. India has largest number of kids with Thalassemia Major. 10,000-15,000 children having this blood disorder born every year in the country. The only cure available for such children is bone marrow transplantation (BMT). However, BMT is difficult and not affordable by the parents of all these children. Therefore, the mainstay of treatment is repeated blood transfusions, followed by regular iron chelation therapy to remove the excessive iron overload, consequent to the multiple blood transfusions.



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NON MEDICAL PROJECTS Launch of Learning App

RCML launched Ideal Learning App in BMC School on 29th April. It supported 500 kids in 10th std by helping them study. The App also has an option to help the kids with their career counselling. The project was done in association with Rotary district 3141. Thank you for your cooperation.

NON MEDICAL PROJECTS Pink Auto Project

On 12th May, Rotary's Pink Auto Project, supported by RC Mumbai Lakers was flagged off. Ms Shamshunisa Sheik, Ms Chandrakala Nag Tilak and Ms Deepali Dhanerav are the three ladies who Lakers have supported. They completed their skill training for permanent livelihood and have received the driving license. Rotary branding and our Club's name will be featured at the back of the autos supported by Lakers. SBI is giving them loan to purchase an autorickshaw. It's an Excellent project & really heartening to see women employed in male dominated profession. It's a happy occasion that our club could support 3 women on their path of self-reliance.





NON MEDICAL PROJECTS Dream Raytale Village, Palghar

It is a Planned Integrated village development in a cluster in Jawahar Taluka, Palghar. It includes Water, Better Homes, Solar, Education, Sewerage, Fruit Tree Plantation, Water wheel etc. In the Dream year, Rotary district 3141 is supporting Construction work of 19 homes at Raytale village, Palghar. The work is in progress. The homes are being constructed for rural poor, homeless, kuchcha house dwellers. Under this scheme, a 25sq m pukka house is being constructed. RCML is supporting construction of one house @ ₹70k.





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NON MEDICAL PROJECTS Supporting MBA Foundation

The MBA Foundation is a self-help organisation, aiming at providing a Life with Self-Esteem and Dignity to differently-abled individuals. They spread awareness of the abilities, strengths and rights of the special needs population.

A differently-abled person does not need our sympathy. Every time we work with a differently-abled person, somewhere, subconsciously many people feel that they are helping them, which in turn makes them feel undesirable. They do not need constant reminders of their limitations, instead they need to be empowered. Sometimes we tend to hand them everything on a platter, out of love, which too increases their feeling of helplessness, relegating them to the role of a receiver. Instead, when we empower them to earn their own livelihood, it gives them not just self-respect but a lot of happiness. Continuing our association with the MBA Foundation, the Rotary Club of Mumbai Lakers supported them financially for their rent and therapist salary to the amount of ₹ 3,00,000 in Dream Year.






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NON MEDICAL PROJECTS Water Wheel distribution

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NON MEDICAL PROJECTS Girl Child Education

A girl child in India is often seen as a liability, a burden to pass on. No matter how talented and ambitious she is, the girl child often receives the shorter end of the stick. These attitudes have massive repercussions in terms of the number of girls who are left out when we consider India's huge population. How can we expect India to turn into the international superpower it has the potential to become when half of our society remains under the shadow of discrimination?

People often underestimate the requirement of funds to achieve this goal. In rural areas, still, girls are seldom sent to school, and even if they are sent to school, they only go up to the primary level and then are pulled out for domestic help. As per the last census, effective literacy rates in India was 82.14% for males and 65.4% for females. We at Rotary Club of Mumbai Lakers (RCML) have been working to bridge this gap.

We all know that when a girl is educated the whole family is educated. RCML has been sponsoring the education of the girl child from underprivileged sections of the society directly by paying the tuition fees of the girls who are unable to do so, as well as working with various NGO partners such as the Kartavya Foundation, . Every single bit of contribution counts. Every year for the last ten years, RCML has earmarked an amount of Rs 4.5 Lakhs towards monetarily helping the marginalized groups of girls such as the very poor and disabled afford education.





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VOCATIONAL PROJECTS Train the Trainer by Stree Mukti Sangathan (SMS)

On 21.04.2022, Vasti Counselling Workshop was organized by Stree Mukti Sanghatana, Family Counselling and Counselling Center, Powai Kendra. The first session was held today. The woman's identity and form were filled in the session. A total of 19 women attended the event. The purpose behind conducting a settlement counselling workshop for women was discussed above.
